I am pleased to announce that my office will be hosting two Pediatric Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Case Review Trainings for Pediatric Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners (SANEs). The trainings will be held on March 29, 2011, in Chicago and June 7, 2011, in Urbana, Illinois.

These free, 4-hour trainings were designed for nurses who have completed the Pediatric SANE Training and are either currently practicing as or in clinical training to become Pediatric SANEs.

The goal of the Pediatric SANE Case Review Trainings is to provide Pediatric SANEs with a case review training opportunity. The trainings will allow Pediatric SANEs to participate in and discuss normal versus abnormal medical-forensic findings in pediatric sexual abuse/assault patient cases. The Pediatric SANE Case Review Trainings will count towards the Illinois Pediatric SANE Program clinical training requirements.

The nursing objectives for the trainings are as follows:

- Discuss pediatric medical-forensic examinations
- Review normal and abnormal findings in pediatric medical-forensic examinations

The Pediatric SANE Case Review Trainings are offered by the Office of the Illinois Attorney General at no cost to the participant. If interested, nurses can earn contact hours through the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) College of Nursing. To obtain nursing contact hours, nurses must pay \$5 to the UIC College of Nursing and complete an online evaluation. Further instructions will be provided at the trainings.
